## Directions

This should be a full version of your paper. Essentially, it is a rough draft. Complete the paper to the best of your ability. **No drafts will be accepted after class has begun**. Be sure to bring two copies of your paper: one to turn into me, and one to give to a peer for peer edits. We will spend the entire class period working on these edits. Your grading for the rough draft will mainly depend on fulfilling the listed requirements below. Missing a specific requirement can drop your grade up to 10%. The quality of the content will only make up a small portion of your grade for this assignment; however, much of my comments will be related to the content. Your revised version will be graded more heavily for content. So, be sure to pay attention to both my edits and your peer's edits.

**Info:** Only attach previous work to the copy you will hand into me. Make sure you include the graded versions of the topic plus 12 sources, working notes, and outline paper clipped to your first draft.

**Info:** Also, upload your paper under the tab "Turn in First Draft Here." This upload should happen by the required due date for the paper.

## Requirements

- 7 or more academic sources, at least 5 of which must be economic journal articles.
- 2 news sources from reputable news organizations.
- 3 sources from books, academic journals, think thanks, etc.
- 2 original figures or tables
- At least one in-text citations from each of your sources (Paraphrase, don't quote).
  - Do not use block quotes, tables, figures, or charts that are not your original work unless absolutely necessary for the paper.
  - If you use them, make sure you cite them fully and properly.
  - Any quotes, tables, figures, or charts used will not count towards the length of your paper.
- MLA format throughout (see "MLA guidelines" in "Course Material" tab on Blackboard).
- Suggested page length 15-22 pages.
- All previous graded assignments should be attached with a paper clip. Your first draft should be stapled.
