## **News Reports**

## Introduction

Over the course of the semester, we will practice discussing topics using economics. Instead of focusing on a few specific topics like most classes, we will look at current issues that individual students find interesting. You will deliver two news reports over the semester. For one presentation, you can choose any relatively current article (going back a maximum of one year). For the other presentation, you must choose an article related to your topic. This article can be relatively older (going back a maximum of two years). Both articles should not be on the same subject. It does not matter the order in which you present the news articles.

There will be 3-4 presentations per day. I will assign the day in which you will present. If you do not present on your scheduled day due to time constraints, then you will be the first to present the next day. You cannot do the same article as another classmate.

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**Info:** News articles should posted in Blackboard Discussion Board, under the thread "News Reports" and under the thread for you specific day, by 2:00 pm a day prior to presenting. Failure to post the news article on time will result in a 50% drop in your grade.

## What Should Be in Each Report

- (1) 1-3 minute summary of article
- (2) 1-2 minute discussion on your opinion
- (3) .5-2 minutes questions for class or something you would like to discuss about it
- (4) 4-5 minutes facilitate classroom discussion. Call classmates by name. Do not dominate the discussion, just facilitate it by keeping it directed and choosing who speaks. Timely submission of your article allows classmates time to read it and will result in better classroom discussion.
- (5) Keep your time for first three items to that listed. Classroom discussion may go longer if time permits and class is engaged.
- (6) If you have a documented excused absence, I will reschedule your news report at my discretion. If you miss your news report without documented and approved excuse, you receive a zero. No make-ups.
