## Introduction

Active engagement in class is one of the most important determinants to your success. You earn your participation grade by accumulating points throughout the semester in various ways. By the end of the semester you need 100 participation points in order to earn $100 \%$ for participation. Points will be updated in Blackboard each week. Participation not earned during days absent, whether excused or not, can be earned by showing solid comprehension of the readings on other days and earning the fourth point on those days. Please see Prof. Cohle if you have questions or concerns about earning your participation. Points will be updated daily to Blackboard. It is possible, but not likely, to earn above $100 \%$ in participation points. Points can be earned in the following ways:

## Ways to Gain Points

(1) Participation in 28 Class Periods (3 points expected for each class)

- 1 point for attending class
- 2 points for participation
- 3 points for informed participation (i.e. referring to readings)
- 4 points for a solid comprehension of the readings
(2) 5 points can be earned by attending the University Wide career fair (must be dressed in professional attire)
(3) 1 peer edit of the first draft, worth 10 points
(4) Company Report, worth 10 points
